Notice of Application for a New Outdoor Patio:

The applicant proposes a 20 person outdoor patio where licenced service hours align with interior hours and are 10 am to 11 pm Sunday to Thursday and 10 am to 12 am Friday and Saturday. The application relates to an existing liquor primary licence that has an interior occupant load of 85 people and the addition of the 20 person outdoor patio will bring the total to 105 people.
