The 6 storey 35 rental unit project by Aryze at 1693 Fort received final approval on April 13th. The other active projects are still at the pre-public hearing stage. You can keep track of them if visit Development Tracker on the City of Victoria website.

Empresa Developments will be doing a very brief, pre-CALUC presentation at our AGM on June 6th regarding their ideas for development of the long-time empty Turner building on the northwest corner of Fort and Richmond. This is North Jubilee LUC territory but Empresa wanted to include South Jubilee since Fort is a shared boundary. There is an information meeting on June 27th at 7pm at Begbie Hall (Woodward Room) with NJNA and the City's Department of Transportation local area plans. South Jubilee is invited to attend.
