Coolkit Workshops in South Jubilee *Counting trees and squirrels*

Victoria Coolkit, the citizen based initiative to combat climate change, held three workshops in South Jubilee this fall led by Dawn Moorhead, who also spearheaded the Coolkit initiative downtown.

Throughout September and October, a group of neighbours got together to discuss and rate how each of our blocks, and our own homes, score on the climate change scale. Our goal was to learn how we could mitigate and adapt to climate change, and take a look at the carbon footprint in our own backyards and on our streets.

Participants noted that they learned so much about what each of us can do individually, and what we can do together as a neighbourhood. Many ideas to improve our neighbourhood came out of these workshops.

The first project we decided on is tree planting. We will apply for a City grant to distribute free trees to be planted in private gardens in South Jubilee. Keep an eye on our newsletter, website, and social media to sign up for your free tree soon!

In addition, members of the Coolkit group and Greening Committee group are planning a series of lectures on sustainability in 2024, educating the neighbourhood and surrounding community on available grants and other initiatives to reduce the carbon in our homes and increase energy efficiency. The family, originally from Syria, currently resides in a refugee camp in Lebanon. Sasha, their sister, was welcomed to Victoria as a refugee and is currently settled here.

The first event in their fundraising campaign is a night of Syrian music, poetry, and food, as well as a silent auction, at Fernwood Community Centre on Saturday, November 4th from 6:30pm - 10:00pm. You are invited to attend the event and help meet their fundraising goals.
