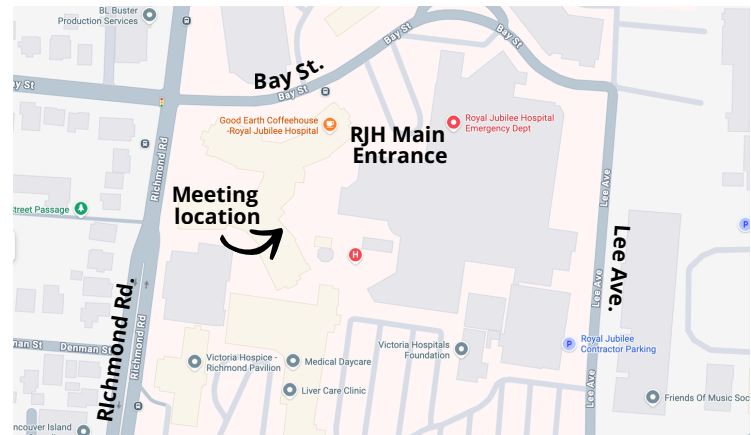

## Christie's Carriage House Pub South Jubilee Business Highlight

The Christie's house, "Sandolphon", was built about 1898, by Eldridge Christie. The decorative and picturesque roofline with the gables and towers are in the Queen Anne style. In 1986, a gorgeously restored Christie's opened for business. Spiffed up in high Edwardian fashion, with dark woods, stained glass, brass rails, a patterned ceiling designed in stamped foil, and fireplaces – Christie's accurately recreates the lush comforts that Eldridge and his family knew. In 1993, due to the popularity of open air patios, Christie's created a fabulous patio, complete with heaters and a fireplace for Victoria's mild winters and open to the beautiful sunshine in the summer.

Today, there is always something happening at Christie's, food or drink specials everyday. Christie's Carriage House Pub recreates turn-of-the-century Victoria with flair, charm and comfort. It is truly the living room of the neighbourhood – a place where friends meet, chat and share good times.
